Welcome to fifth grade! We look forward to meeting your students this fall. In order to prepare for the back to school season, here are a few recommendations and requests along with a few tips about next year from the fifth grade teachers.

**Over the summer, please encourage your children to continue to read for at least 20 minutes daily. Please be sure that students have memorized basic multiplication facts. Some fun and helpful websites include:**

Students in fifth grade change classrooms for some academic subjects and will need to stay organized in a way that will prepare them for junior high. Coming to school prepared each day with completed assignments (expect homework), along with the items listed below will help your child have a successful year.

**Supplies fifth graders will need in their desk:**

- **5 colored folders** (plastic recommended) for the following subjects (you may want to buy extra folders in order to replace them throughout the year)
  - Reading- purple
  - Writing - red
  - Math - blue
  - Science - green
  - Social Studies - yellow
  - Homework folder - your choice
- **Notebooks:** 2 large wide ruled composition (one needs to be green), and 3 single-subject wide-ruled spiral bound (recommended colors red, blue, and yellow)
- Plenty of pencils with a cloth pencil pouch-no boxes please
- 4 different color highlighters
- Small pencil sharpener
- Small box of colored pencils and/or small box of fine point markers
- Scissors
- a large glue stick or two small
- earbuds or headphones to keep in their desk
- Dry erase markers (fine-point)

**Please DO NOT buy your child a big binder or trapper keeper. They are not needed and end up as tripping hazards!**
